The East Hopewell Township Board of Supervisors met at the Municipal Building, 8916 Hickory Road, Felton, PA at 7:00 p.m. Members present were: Dean Miller, William Rinas, and Richard Seitz, Jr. Also attending the meeting was: Solicitor William Poole, Michael Lee, Roy Hiller III, Larry Zimmerman, Curtis Moser, James Kefauver, Lori Badders, and Ira Walker, Jr.

Chairman Miller opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by William Rinas and seconded by Richard Seitz, Jr. to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

Ira Walker, Jr., Chief of Eureka Fire and Ambulance Co., Inc. reported to the Board of Supervisors that Eureka responded to 385 fire/rescue calls in 2009, with forty-four (44) calls being in East Hopewell Township. Eureka averaged ten (10) members per incident for fire calls. The number of members responding per incident has dropped from thirteen (13) members per call in 2008. Chief Walker informed the Board that Eureka has responded to fifty (50) calls in 2010. In closing, Chief Walker thanked the Board of Supervisors for their continuing support for the Fire Company.

Michael Lee of EML (Codes Enforcement) Inc. discussed with the Board of Supervisors a complaint filed against the owner of the property located at 9377 Hickory Road. Mr. Lee informed the Board that during his inspection of the property he found approximately thirty (30) to forty (40) bags of trash stockpiled and that he will be sending a zoning violation notice.
